Connx⁺MD 4.0

TeamPraxis completed the rollout of ConnxtMD 4.0. The accounting and workflow features, reporting, and scheduling systems have been completely redesigned to offer a more streamlined user interface. ConnxtMD represents over 15 years of deep local reimbursement knowledge and community connectivity. As a best of breed technology and one of the most advanced web based solutions available across the country, ConnxtMD provides a pathway to the future for practices considering upgrading to browser based practice management system. ConnxtMD 4.0 is integrated to our electronic health record solution, real time eligibility and claims status with local payers and lab results with Clinical and Diagnostic Laboratories. Information can be accessed from anywhere, home, office or anywhere our clients have a high-speed internet connection.

MISYS

Our IT team successfully installed a new IBM RS 6000 server for our MisysPM system. Our team's goal was to make this transition for over 300 providers completely seamless. The purchase of the box, coordinating with vendors, testing and quality assurance services our team provided were all part of our one-stop-shop for our clients.

In addition to new hardware we have also upgraded the MisysPM application to version 7.0.2. This upgrade was a necessary part of continued regulatory requirements for the CMS 1500 and National Provider ID claim filing requirements.



Nearly eight years had passed since the last upgrade to the Medical ABC application. The TeamPraxis developers were able to take the source code written nearly 20 years ago and make all the changes required for the NPI, CMS 1500 and EMC secondary requirements due in 2007. Over 400 physicians continue to trust TeamPraxis with the upgrades and support for Medical ABC.
