# Hawaii technology firm goes national

**TeamPraxis**, a Honolulu high-technology firm, has signed with national clinical software provider **Allscripts** to distribute its medical software application to more than 40,000 doctors across the United States.

TeamPraxis specializes in developing health-care technology applications such as electronic medical records and practice management software in Hawaii. This is its first foray into the national market.

The Allscripts Clinical Quality Solution Powered by TeamPraxis software allows physicians to monitor clinical information for patients with chronic diseases through an automated program. It pools information from the patient's health record to alert doctors as to when medications are running out and appointments need to be scheduled.

TeamPraxis' two-year agreement with Allscripts (Nasdaq:MDRX) includes royalty sharing and potentially could generate as much as \$18 million in revenue, according to TeamPraxis CEO Creighton Arita.
