



GPRO Web Interface Reporting

How CQS Helps Automate the Process Using the Patient-Centered Care (PCC) Channel and the GPRO Web Reporting Tool

1. For reporting, use CQS as follows

- Download your Patient XML files from CMS
- Load your Patient XML files into the GPRO Web Reporting Tool
- For all matched patients, the GPRO Web Tool automatically finds and fills in all of the data available in CQS that CMS requires
- Upload the updated Patient XML files to the CMS GPRO Web Interface Portal

2. During the reporting year, use the PCC Measures and Pursuit List below to optimize measure results

- Use the CMS ACO Thematic Measures Summary Pursuit List
 - Filter by Medicare ACO patients (or Medicare patients if you are not participating in the ACO program)
 - Work near-due and overdue patients (orange, red and blue measure status)

About Thematic Overlap Measures

Thematic overlap measures are designed to be physician friendly and to enable practical workflows. One thematic measure guides providers and their care team to do what is required for multiple payer measures (and multiple programs). Thematic overlap measures have additional benefits when compared to payer measures as shown below.

	PCC Thematic Overlap Measures	Payer Measures (i.e., PQRS, MU, HEDIS)
Relevance	Evidence-based measures based on patient demographics, disease state and previous clinical data entered; no patients left out	Encounter-based for “grading” purposes; results in patients with gaps in care being filtered out to achieve repeatable grading
Timing	No reporting restrictions on prompting for care – true clinical decision support	Reporting period restricts when care can be delivered and still count toward a measure
Understandable	Patient centric view of physician relevant data	Difficult to interpret measures with complex logic, filters and special cases to make scores work out for payers
